SUBJECT: APPROVE THE INSTALLATION OF “NO STOPPING ANYTIME” SIGNS, AND ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 11-1637, MODIFYING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF REYES ADOBE ROAD, BETWEEN AGOURA ROAD AND THE REYES ADOBE BRIDGE

As part of the recently completed US 101/Reyes Adobe Interchange improvements, the travel lanes between Agoura Road and the Reyes Adobe Bridge were reconfigured in order to properly line up with the lanes on the expanded bridge. As a result of the reconfigured lanes, the shoulder areas will no longer be adequate to accommodate parked vehicles.

The previous Reyes Adobe Road configuration prohibited parking in most areas, but was permissible on a portion of the west side where there was adequate width due to the narrow bridge. Motorists wishing to rideshare would take advantage of this area by parking a vehicle during working hours. With the bridge expansion, this portion of Reyes Adobe Road is no longer conducive to this situation on the east and west sides. Therefore, the City’s Traffic Engineer recommends modifying the parking restrictions by adding “No Stopping Anytime” signs and red curb on both sides of Reyes Adobe Road, between Agoura Road and the bridge, to restrict vehicles from stopping or parking to ensure a driver’s safety is not compromised.

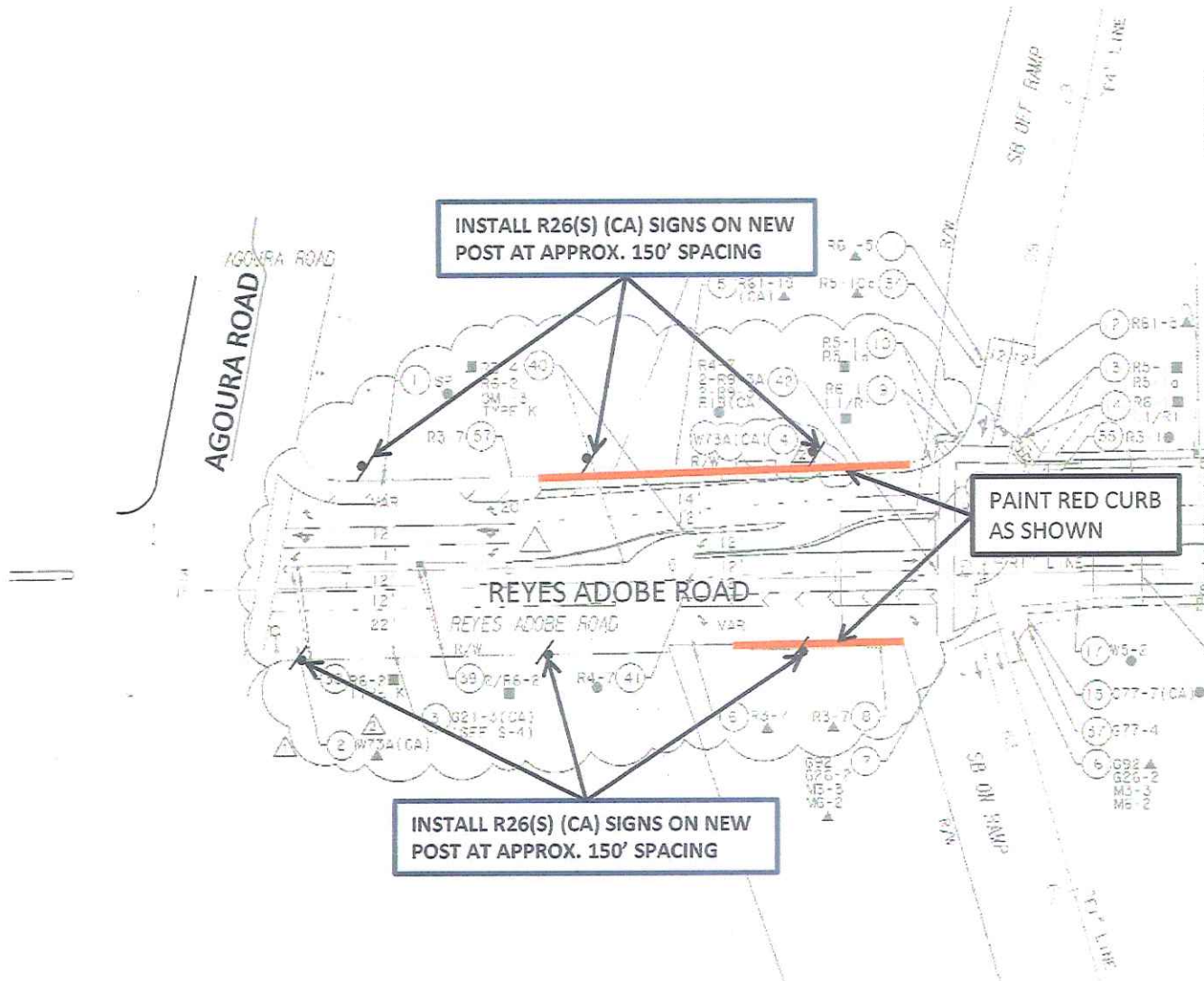
With City Council approval, the new regulatory signs would be installed by the City’s Public Works Contractor within a few weeks. In addition, the Lost Hills Sheriff’s Traffic Division will be notified of the changes, allowing for immediate enforcement of the new restrictions.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council approve the installation of “No Stopping Anytime” signs, and adopt Resolution No. 11-1637, which will cause the implementation of the new parking restrictions along the east and west sides of Reyes Adobe Road, between Agoura Road and the Reyes Adobe Bridge.

RESOLUTION NO. 11-1637

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, MODIFYING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF REYES ADOBE ROAD, BETWEEN AGOURA ROAD AND THE REYES ADOBE BRIDGE

WHEREAS, public concern has been expressed for the need to prevent vehicles from stopping along the east and west sides of Reyes Adobe Road, between Agoura Road and the Reyes Adobe Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer has determined that Reyes Adobe Road is only wide enough for travel lanes; with no additional room for stopping along the curb; and,

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code permits local authorities to restrict parking on streets under their jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer is recommending that "No Stopping Any Time" signs be installed on the east and west sides of Reyes Adobe Road between, Agoura Road and the overpass, to mitigate the public's concerns; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills adopt Resolution No. 11-1637, establishing "No Parking Any Time" restrictions on the east and west sides of Reyes Adobe Road, between Agoura Road and the Reyes Adobe Bridge.
