Las Virgenes Municipal Water District to Begin New Pipeline Project in the City of Agoura Hills

(Agoura Hills, CA—FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE) -- Beginning in August, the Las Virgenes Water District (LVMWD) will start work to install a new potable water pipeline as part of their system-wide improvements which will ensure adequate water volume during peak demand periods, and improve the reliability of their distribution system. The new 18-inch water line will run south along Reyes Adobe Road from the intersection with Thousand Oaks Boulevard to Agoura Road; then easterly along Agoura Road to Cornell Road. The project is slated for completion in June 2012.

“The LVMWD has been coordinating with our staff for over a year”, Agoura Hills City Engineer Ramiro Adeva said. “Fortunately, their crews were able to install the casings for the pipeline in the recently improved Reyes Adobe Bridge before construction was completed. Adeva went on to explain, “There will be some minor disturbance near the west side of the bridge to allow for the pipe to be inserted through the casing. However, this foresight during the construction of the interchange was essential in preserving the integrity and aesthetics of the new bridge, since it eliminates the need to trench through the bridge deck itself when the District does their work.”
