After an initial warning citation, any subsequent violation of this chapter is a misdemeanor, <u>or infraction, at the discretion of the City Prosecutor</u>, punishable pursuant to Chapter 2 (Penalties) of Article I (General Provisions) of this Code.

- ACTION: Following discussion, the motion by Councilmember Koehler, to introduce, read by title only, and waive second reading of <u>Ordinance No.</u> <u>11-390</u>, as amended, was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Kuperberg, and approved 5-0.
- 2. Discussion to Introduce, Read by Title Only, and Waive Further Reading of <u>Ordinance</u> <u>No. 11-391</u>; AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING TITLE 15 OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY CODE, AS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE, ADOPTING PARKING REGULATIONS FOR CITY-OWNED AND CITY-OPERATED PARKING FACILITIES AND AMENDING ARTICLE III OF THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE; and to Set a Public Hearing for December 14, 2011
