The Heschel West School item is scheduled for consideration by the County of Los Angeles Regional Planning Commission at their meeting the morning of June 28, 2006.

The City Council will be asked to provide direction to staff on whether or not to appeal the decision of the Regional Planning Commission in regards to the Heschel West School project.
