**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK BIDS FOR FY 2006-07 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT; NIB 06-01**

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Staff is requesting authorization to seek bids for the FY 2006-07 Street Resurfacing Project; NIB 06-01. The scope of work consists of resurfacing 35 residential streets (over 8 lane-miles) with rubberized asphalt concrete (RAC). A project map/street list is attached. The use of RAC provides our City streets several advantages over conventional asphalt concrete, such as increased resistance to reflective cracking, providing a quieter ride and better striping contrast; all while recycling used tires.

The list of streets to be paved is in accordance with the City's 2005 Pavement Management System (PMS) report. This report provides an orderly listing of all the City's public roads and their condition. Combined with the analysis of field and technical data, the report provides the City with a priority listing of streets in need of rehabilitation.

The FY 2006-07 project budget includes \$750,000 from the General Fund, \$100,000 from the Gas Tax Fund, and \$84,000 of Proposition 42 funds for a total of \$934,000. Staff expects to return to Council in August for the contract award and commence construction in September.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council approve the Plans and Specifications and authorize staff to seek bids for the FY 2006-07 Street Resurfacing Project; NIB 06-01.
