Subject: *Review for Palo Comado Canyon Road Widening Project*

This is in response to your memorandum dated June 6, 2011 requesting to review the revised initial site assessment report (ISA dated May 13 2011, prepared by Kleinfelder for City of Agoura Hills) for the above-referenced project. This project proposes to improve Palo Comado Canyon Road and the US 101-Palo Comado Canyon Road interchange in the City of Agoura Hills, County of Los Angeles. The project has 2 alternatives: Alternative 1 – No Build, and Alternative 2 – Build. The build alternative would include widening the Palo Comado Canyon Road Overcrossing (OC) from one lane to two lanes in each direction with median and sidewalks, modifying the northbound on- and off-ramps, and modifying the intersections.

We have completed our review and revised ISA report addresses all the comments sent in letter dated February 2, 2011. Therefore, we approve the ISA for this project.
