SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT WITH ALL CITY MANAGEMENT

SERVICES FOR CONTINUED CROSSING GUARD SERVICE

Staff is seeking City Council approval for the renewal of the agreement with All City Management Services to provide crossing guard services throughout our community, which will expire on June 30, 2006. Staff is recommending that the agreement be renewed for the time period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

The annual agreement amount is not to exceed \$65,000. This agreement amount remains the same as the past fiscal year, as there was not a price increase requested. This amount has been accounted for accordingly in the fiscal year 2006-2007 budget.

All City Management Services has provided the City with excellent service for the past several years. In addition, they have well trained personnel that provide uninterrupted crossing guard service to our community throughout the school year. They have assisted the City in identifying possible safety hazards and maintenance issues around the school areas they service. City staff has been pleased with their flexibility to address certain requests and the quality of the personnel supplied.

The proposed agreement has been reviewed by the City Attorney and approved as to form.

## RECOMMENDATION

Staff is recommending the City Council approve the agreement renewal with All City Management Services for crossing guard services from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 in a not to exceed amount of \$65,000.
