SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE THE PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF PARTICIPATION

IN THE STORMWATER FUNDING OPTIONS WORK PLAN

The California Contract Cities Association (CCCA) recently contacted the City Managers of Los Angeles County to gauge interest in supporting an effort to collectively fund a comprehensive work program focused on ways to meet current and future water quality funding needs.

Since the failed attempt of the Clean Water, Clean Beaches Measure in 2012, a City Manager's Work Group and Steering Committee comprised of elected officials was formed to provide feedback and direction on how best to move forward. As a result, the Steering Committee created a work plan containing a multitude of recommendations.

At this point, it remains too early to comment on the specifics of implementing the recommendations, however, checking "YES" on the attached Preliminary Ballot, gives initial notification to those agencies sharing similar water quality funding concerns, to learn more about the work plan, and to be informed of actual costs based on a definitive funding formula.

This action does not guarantee participation, involvement, or commitment of any financial resources at this time, but merely states that the City is willing to consider its participation in the Steering Committee's Funding Options Work Plan upon further discussion. The City's response in this regard is being requested by February 20, 2015.

If, after further discussions, it is determined to be beneficial for the City to formally declare its participation, staff will return to the City Council with a future agenda item.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council authorize the preliminary approval of participation in the stormwater funding options work plan
