Mayor Buckley Weber acknowledged that the Catlins had made a significant contribution, was impressed with the organization, leaders, and kids, and thanked Councilmember Weber for his efforts in helping to bring the Boys & Girls Club to Agoura Hills and the Conejo Valley.
