SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK BIDS FOR FY 2014-15 ANNUAL
CONCRETE REPAIR PROJECT; NIB 15-01

For the past five years, the City has contracted with FS Construction to repair damaged concrete sidewalks, curbs, and gutters throughout the City. With the expiration of their contract on June 30, 2014, staff is requesting authorization to seek bids in order to provide an opportunity for qualified firms to compete for the contract and to ensure the City is getting the best prices the industry has to offer.

The initial term of the contract will be three (3) years, beginning this fiscal year. As with previous concrete contracts, the specifications allow the contract to be extended with the mutual agreement of the City and the contractor, up to two (2) additional one-year periods. The extension shall be based on the term, conditions, and bid prices of the initial contract and may be increased or decreased annually by a percentage determined by the California Consumer Prices Index.

The FY 2014-15 project budget includes \$50,000 from the Gas Tax Fund, \$20,000 of Proposition C Funds, and \$16,634 from the City's annual Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 allocation, for a total of \$86,634. Staff expects to return to Council in May for the contract award and commence construction by June. Construction is anticipated to take approximately two (2) weeks, with no work to be done on holidays.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council authorize staff to seek bids for the FY 2014-15 Annual Concrete Repair Project; NIB 15-01.
