SUBJECT: CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE LADYFACE COURT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; NIB NO. 16-01

On March 24, 2016, the City received four (4) sealed bids for the Ladyface Court Improvements Project; NIB 16-01. The project includes installation of irrigation and lighting conduit, construction of new sidewalk, curb and gutter from the driveway of the City Hall's parking lot to just east of the Recreation Center Driveway, removal and replacement of two (2) commercial driveway aprons, and construction and landscaping of a raised curb planter at the south end of Ladyface Court.

The bid results were as follows:

Pacific Tennis Courts, Inc.	\$149,990.00
Berry General Engineering Contractors, Inc.	\$198,653.00
Toro General Engineering Contractors	\$218,334.00
C.A. Rasmussen, Inc.	\$297,100.00

Staff reviewed the bid submittal of the apparent low bidder, Pacific Tennis Courts Inc., and determined that the bid proposal meets the requirements for this project. Staff contacted references to discuss Pacific Tennis Courts work, and the references indicated they were satisfied with the contractor's performance. The company is based in Moorpark, California.

The FY 2015-16 budget includes \$150,000 of General Fund money to complete the project. Work is anticipated to commence in May, and take approximately thirty (30) days to complete, with no work to be done on holidays.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council award the contract for the Ladyface Court Improvements Project; NIB 16-01, to Pacific Tennis Courts, Inc., in the amount of \$149,990.00.
