UPGRADES

As part of the five-year Information Technology Improvement Plan, software upgrades were budgeted FY 2015/16. The City needs to upgrade Microsoft SQL Server, Miscrosoft Windows Server Datacenter, Microsoft Office, Microsoft Exchange and Adobe Acrobat, because existing software is outdated.

Southern Computer Warehouse was the apparent low bidder. Staff reviewed the bid submittal of the apparent low bidder, Southern Computer Warehouse, and deemed their bid responsive and acceptable. There are sufficient funds appropriated in the FY 2015/16 budget to cover the purchase of the software.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council award the bid to Southern Computer Warehouse in the amount of \$39,729.03
