SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK BIDS FOR THE OLD AGOURA PARK

EQUESTRIAN ARENA FOOTING REPLACEMENT PROJECT:

NIB 16-04

Staff is requesting authorization to seek bids for the Old Agoura Park Equestrian Arena Footing Replacement Project; NIB 16-04. The scope of work consists of removing and replacing the existing equestrian arena footing with a more well-draining footing material, as well as adding sub-base to the footing to help facilitate drainage and to stabilize the footing. A sub-surface drainage system consisting of filter fabric, perforated pipe, and gravel will also be installed within the sub-grade of the horse arena to help carry water away from the facility.

The adopted FY 2016/17 budget includes Prop A Maintenance and Servicing Funds to cover the project costs. Staff expects to return to Council in October for the contract award and commence construction shortly thereafter, with expected project completion in November 2016.

This item has been reviewed by the Community Services Subcommittee and various representatives from the Old Agoura Homeowner's Association. Maintenance contractors were also contacted for feedback in preparation of the project's plans and specifications.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council approve the authorization to seek bids for the Old Agoura Park Equestrian Arena Footing Replacement Project; NIB 16-04.
