**SUBJECT:** AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK BIDS FOR FY 2016-17 ANNUAL  
CONCRETE REPAIR PROJECT; NIB NO. 16-05

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Staff is requesting authorization to seek bids for the FY 2016-17 Annual Concrete Repair Project; NIB No.16-05. The scope of work consists of repairing damaged concrete sidewalks, curb, and gutters throughout the City.

The initial term of the contract will be three (3) years, beginning this fiscal year with allowance for the contract to be extended upon the mutual agreement of the City and the contractor, up to two (2) additional one-year periods. Any extension shall be based on the term, conditions, and bid prices of the initial contract and may be increased or decreased annually by a percentage determined by the California Consumer Prices Index.

The FY 2016-17 project budget includes \$50,000 from the Gas Tax Fund, \$13,533 from the City's Annual Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 allocation, and \$35,000 of General Funds for concrete repairs at Reyes Adobe Park, for a total of \$86,634. Staff expects to return to Council in December for the contract award and commence construction by February of 2017. Construction is anticipated to take approximately thirty-five (35) days.

### RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council authorize staff to seek bids for the FY 2016-17 Annual Concrete Repair Project; NIB 16-05.
