SUBJECT:

CONSIDER A 48-FOOT VERSUS 64-FOOT CROSS-SECTION FOR THE PROPOSED WILDLIFE CORRIDOR TUNNEL ON AGOURA ROAD,

WEST OF LIBERTY CANYON ROAD

As part of Caltrans' efforts to prepare the environmental documents for the Wildlife Corridor Project, a decision must ultimately be made on the cross-section of the proposed 200-foot tunnel over Agoura Road, within the City limits.

The width of the two cross-sections being considered is 48 feet and 64 feet. The height of the proposed tunnel will also need to be determined, with the final acceptable vertical clearance being somewhere between 16.5 feet and 20 feet directly above any vehicular travel lanes.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council:

- 1. Discuss/consider the merits of the width and height dimensions being presented, and individually indicate support for a particular cross-section, or
- 2. Discuss/consider the merits of the width and height dimensions being presented, and make no immediate decision, but instead, direct staff to consider the City Council's feedback and return at a later Regular City Council Meeting to make a final cross-section recommendation.
