SUBJECT: ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 16-1829, APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF "NO PARKING ANYTIME" SIGNS TO RESTRICT PARKING FOR APPROXIMATELY 311 FEET ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF DRIVER

AVENUE, WEST OF COLODNY DRIVE (SOUTH)

Public safety concerns have recently been expressed by residents regarding vehicles that have been parking along a curved portion of Driver Avenue, just west of Colodny Drive (south). The parked vehicles are obstructing the visibility of motorists wishing to make a left turn onto Colodny Drive (north). In addition, vehicles traveling eastbound on Driver Avenue are frequently crossing the double yellow line into opposing traffic as a result of the parked vehicles.

After completing a site visit to review the field conditions, the City's Traffic Engineer recommends installing "No Parking Anytime" signs along the south side of Driver Avenue. beginning at Colodny Drive (south) to the end of the existing curb and gutter, which is approximately 311 feet to the west. This will ensure that parked cars are not obstructing the views of motorists, and that the safety of drivers, in both directions, are protected in this area.

With City Council approval, signs would be installed by the City's Public Works Contractor within a couple weeks. In addition, the Lost Hills Sheriff's Traffic Division will be notified of the changes in order to enforce the new restrictions.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council adopt Resolution No. 16-1829, approving the installation of "No Parking Anytime" signs to restrict parking for approximately 311 feet on the south side of Driver Avenue, west of Colodny Drive (south).

RESOLUTION NO. 16-1829

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF "NO PARKING ANYTIME" SIGNS TO RESTRICT PARKING FOR APPROXIMATELY 311 FEET ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF DRIVER AVENUE, WEST OF COLODNY DRIVE (SOUTH)

WHEREAS, public safety concerns have been expressed for the need to establish a parking policy that prohibits parked vehicles from creating line-of-sight problems; and,

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code permits local authorities to restrict parking on streets under their jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer has determined there is a line-of-site problem at the curved portion of Driver Avenue, and thus, a need to restrict vehicles from parking any time along this portion of roadway to maintain clear line-of-sight; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer is recommending "No Parking Anytime" signs be installed along the south side of Driver Avenue, beginning at Colodny Drive (south) to the end of the existing curb and gutter, approximately 311 feet to the west, to maintain line-of-sight; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills adopts Resolution No. 16-1829, establishing parking restrictions on the south side of Driver Avenue from Colodny Drive (south), to approximately 311 feet west. by installing "No Parking Anytime" signs.
