# SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY ADOPTION COMPANY FOR ADDITIONAL WEED ABATEMENT AND TRASH PICK-UP ALONG CITY STREETS AND FREEWAY CORRIDOR.

The purpose of this report is seek City Council approval to enter a professional services agreement with *California Highway Adoption Company* to provide additional weed abatement and trash pick-up along city streets and the freeway corridor.

At the September 28, 2005 Council meeting, staff prepared a list of potential projects for consideration as part of the FY2005-06 Citywide Beautification. Included in the list of projects were additional services for weed abatement and trash pick-up throughout the City and the US 101 Freeway corridor.

Staff was approached by *California Highway Adoption Company* in August, and found there are a limited number of companies that provide the types of services the City will require to keep the community clean of debris. In addition, *California Highway Adoption Company* currently provides services for communities such as Thousand Oaks, Pismo Beach, and Monterey.

The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the proposed agreement as to form.

### RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council:

- 1. Approve entering into a Professional Services Agreement with California Highway Adoption Company in the amount of \$60,000; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the attached agreement.
