SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK BIDS FOR THE CHUMASH PARK ACCESS

PATHS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; NIB 16-07

Staff is requesting authorization to seek bids for the Chumash Park Access Paths Improvements Project; NIB 16-07. On March 23, 2016, the City Council approved Resolution No. 16-1810, which identified the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs and projects for Fiscal Year 2016-17. As part of the approval, \$54,734 of CDBG Funds were allocated for constructing improvements at Chumash Park.

The scope of work consists of replacing existing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible paths of travel serving the playground equipment area and the baseball field. Both paths are accessed from the existing sidewalk on the south side of Medea Valley Drive, and vary from 6-10 feet in width, and 100 feet in length.

Staff expects to return to Council in March 2017 for the contract award and commence construction shortly thereafter. Construction is anticipated to take approximately thirty (30) days.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council authorize staff to seek bids for the Chumash Park Access Paths Improvements Project; NIB 6-07.
