The City of Agoura Hills Department of Community Services is pleased to announce the Fall 2017 Enrichment schedule. **ALL** registrations will go directly through the City of Agoura Hills. Registration: PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED through the City of Agoura Hills. Students not registered will be sent to the Front Office. Refunds, credits or transfers are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the start of the second week of classes. Register online at www.agourahillsrec.org or in-person at 29900 Ladyface Court, Agoura Hills. Discounts will not be given for late registrations.

Program Dates: Week of September 5th – October 16th (7 weeks). **Deadline for Enrollment:** Friday, September 1st at 6:00 p.m. (registrations received after this time will be charged a \$15 late fee)

Check in Procedures:

- Mon/Tu/Th/Fri: Students will walk over to the enrichment classroom (Grades J-1st will be escorted to the classroom).
- Wednesday: Journeys/Kindergarten students will be walked over to their classroom. 1st grade will be escorted to lunch tables. Grades 2-5 will walk themselves to the lunch tables (have your child bring a lunch or they can purchase a hot lunch).

Pick-Up Procedures:

Students Journeys-1st will need to be picked up in person at their enrichment class. Grades 2nd – 5th can either be picked up at the classroom or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.

IMPORTANT: Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA. Students are not allowed to wait unattended after their enrichment class.

The enrichment program is privately run and is no way affiliated with Willow Elementary school and/or Las Virgenes Unified School District

City of Agoura Hills Department of Community Services Behavior Policy

It is our goal to provide a safe, positive and fun experience for all participants in our programs. In order to achieve this goal, the following program policies must be followed:

Expected Behavior

- Be respectful and courteous to staff.
- Be respectful of the feelings of others.
- Participate in planned activities.
- Follow instructions and rules given by staff.
- Exhibit and maintain positive attitudes toward the environment and facilities.
- Exhibit and maintain respect for all property, facilities and equipment, both public and private.
- Adhere to all rules and regulations.

Unacceptable Behavior

- **Vandalism.** Damaging city property or the property of others.
- **Theft.** Stealing property or equipment of others.
- **Abusive language, swearing or profanity.** No profanity, vulgar language or swearing. This also includes abusive language (i.e. name calling, etc.), obscene gestures and threats of injury towards others.
- **Fighting.** No physical fighting (i.e. pushing, shoving, hitting, etc.). If you have a problem with others in the program, discuss the problem with Staff. If a fight breaks-out, the participants (including anyone who encourages the fighting) will be subject to immediate suspension.
- **Touching.** Our recreation program policy is one of "hands-off." Holding hands, arm-in-arm, hugging and kissing are not appropriate. Sexual harassment or indecency will not be tolerated.
- **Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco and other Substances.** Taking, distributing, or possessing illegal drugs or tobacco is prohibited and is grounds for immediate suspension. Permanent felt pens, aerosol spray cans of any type, glue and whiteout are not to be brought.
- **Weapons or Dangerous Objects.** Possession of any firearm, knife, explosive or other dangerous object is prohibited and is grounds for immediate suspension.

Discipline Policy

Except as indicated above, consequences for misbehavior are usually progressive and reflect the severity of the unacceptable behavior. Notwithstanding, one severe act could lead to expulsion from our programs. Any criminal act will be reported immediately to law enforcement officials.

Listed below is a progression of discipline:

- **First Offense:** Parent/guardian notification; Warning; Time out from group/Loss of privileges (period of time to be determined by incident and age of participant)
- **Second Offense:** Parent/guardian notification; Time out from group/loss of privileges (period of time to be determined by incident and age of participant); Parent/guardian notified to pick up participant from program; possible suspension
- **Third Offense:** Parent/guardian notification; Suspension; Expulsion; Parent/guardian notified to pick up participant from program

No refund will be given if a participant is suspended or expelled from the program.
