Yerba Buena After-school Enrichment – Fall 2017

Registration: PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Students not registered will be sent to the Front Office. Register online at <u>www.agourahillsrec.org</u> or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center – 29900 Ladyface Court. Refunds, credits or transfers are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the start of the <u>second week of classes</u>. Discounts will not be given for late registrations. <u>Register before 6:00pm on September 1st and receive a \$10 discount</u>. The enrichment program is privately run and is no way affiliated with Willow Elementary school and/or Las Virgenes Unified School District

Parent Pick-Up Procedures:

Journeys and Kindergarten students will need to be picked up in person at their enrichment class. Grades 1st – 5th can either be picked up at the classroom or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Class Rooms:

Once the enrichment classrooms are assigned, parents will be notified where the class is located.

<u>27 minute Club</u>: 1st – 3rd graders taking enrichment on Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri are automatically enrolled into 27 minute club from 2:06-2:33pm and will go to enrichment directly afterwards.

<u>After School:</u> Kindergarten and Journeys students will be picked up at their classroom on by the enrichment teacher and brought to their classroom (this doesn't apply to 2:45pm classes). Students in grades 1st – 5th will need to walk over to the enrichment room after school. On Wednesday all grades will meet at the lunch tables.

Important: Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.
