Yerba Buena After School Enrichment – Spring 1st 2018

Registration: PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Students not registered will be sent to the Front Office. Register online at www.agourahillsrec.org or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center – 29900 Ladyface Court. Refunds, credits or transfers are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the start of the second-week of classes. Discounts will not be given for late registrations. www.agourahillsrec.org or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and February are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the start of the second-week of classes. Discounts will not be given for late registrations. Register before 6:00pm on February 15th and receive a \$10 discount. The enrichment program is privately run and is no way affiliated with Willow Elementary school and/or Las Virgenes Unified School District.

Parent Pick-Up Procedures:

Journeys and Kindergarten students will need to be picked up in person at their enrichment class. Grades $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ can either be picked up at the classroom or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Class Rooms:

Once the enrichment classrooms are assigned, parents will be notified where the class is located.

27 minute Club: 1st – 3rd graders taking enrichment on Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri are automatically enrolled into 27 minute club from 2:06-2:33pm and will go to enrichment directly afterwards.

After School: Kindergarten and Journeys students will be picked up at their classroom by the enrichment teacher and brought to their enrichment classroom. Students in grades 1st – 5th will need to walk over to the enrichment room after school. On Wednesdays, all grades will meet at the lunch tables.

<u>Important:</u> Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.
