According to NPS, in studying 61 mountain lions over the last 15 years, none have ever behaved aggressively towards people.

We will be working with CDFW, California Native Plant Society, US Fish and Wildlife; National Park Service; Cal Fire and MRCA to select plant species and plant fire resistant vegetation and native to the area, as recommended by the Forestry Division of the Los Angeles County Fire Department. Caltrans will work with Cal Fire to come up with additional suggestions for fire safety.


