ORDINANCE NO. 18-438: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE AGOURA HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO REVISED REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE PROVISIONS OF INCLUSIONARY HOUSING; AND PROPOSED UPDATES TO THE INCLUSIONARY HOUSING ORDINANCE IN-LIEU FEES (CASE NO. ZOA-01250-2016) (CITY OF

AGOURA HILLS, APPLICANT)

On May 3, 2018, the Planning Commission recommended approval of an ordinance to amend the Agoura Hills Municipal Code to revise regulations applicable to the provisions of inclusionary housing. The ordinance, and request to adopt updated in-lieu fees pursuant to the inclusionary housing ordinance, were subsequently publicly noticed for the City Council's consideration and adoption at the June 13, 2018, City Council meeting.

Staff is requesting additional time to further refine this item and related materials for the City Council's consideration. As such, staff will re-notice the public hearing for this item for a future City Council meeting date, and no action is required by the City Council at this time.
