SUBJECT: **CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 ANNUAL
CONCRETE REPAIR PROJECT; NIB 18-05**

On July 11, 2018, the City Council authorized staff to seek bids for the FY 2018-19 Annual Concrete Repair Project; NIB 18-05. The scope of work consists of repairing damaged concrete sidewalks, ramps, curbs, and gutters throughout the City.

On August 30, 2018, the City received three (3) sealed bids for this project. The bid results were as follows:

FS Contractors, Inc.	\$72,769.25
Minako America Corporation	\$80,059.00
Granite Construction Company	\$114,278.40

Staff reviewed the bid submittal of the apparent low bidder, FS Contractors, Inc., and deemed their bid responsive and acceptable. FS Contractors, Inc., has completed several concrete projects for Agoura Hills with exceptional results.

The initial term of the contract will be three (3) years, beginning this fiscal year. As with previous concrete contracts, the specifications allow the contract to be extended, with the mutual agreement of the City and the contractor, up to two (2) additional one-year periods. The extension shall be based on the term, conditions, and bid prices of the initial contract and may be increased or decreased annually by a percentage determined by the California Consumer Prices Index.

The FY 2018-19 project budget includes \$60,000 of Measure M (Local), and \$13,722 from the City's Annual Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 allocation, for a total of \$73,722. Construction will commence in October and the work will take approximately forty-five (45) days to complete, with no work to be done on holidays.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the City Council award the contract for the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Annual Concrete Repair Project; NIB 18-05, to FS Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$72,769.25.
