After School:

- Journeys/Kindergarten 1st Grade: Students will be escorted to their Enrichment class.
- 2nd 5th Grade: Student will walk over to the Enrichment class.
- Wednesday: Journeys/Kindergarten and 1st Grade students will be escorted to their class/lunch tables. Grades 2nd 5th will walk themselves to the lunch tables. Supervised lunch is from 12:10-12:45pm.

Pick-Up Procedures:

Journeys and Kindergarten students will need to be picked up in person at the Kinder yard. Grades $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ can either be picked up at the front of the school or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.

<u>Important:</u> Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA.
