SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 05-1384; COMMEMORATING THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS (SCAG) AND CELEBRATING THEIR 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF SERVICE TO THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA REGION

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) is celebrating its 40th Anniversary this year and is undertaking a series of activities to commemorate its four decades of service to the Southern California region.

With the help of local governments like Agoura Hills, SCAG has pursued regional solutions to issues of common concern, including Heal the Bay. SCAG has helped develop unprecedented regional consensus and unity behind a package of transportation, legislative and funding priorities. SCAG is now working closely with local governments to begin the process of implementing a new vision for how the region can grow and prosper.

Staff believes it appropriate to recognize SCAG and adopt a resolution to commemorate its service to the Southern California region.
