SUBJECT: PLANNING COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS

Pursuant to Section 2802 of the Agoura Hills Municipal Code, the Planning Commission shall consist of five members, each of whom shall be a resident of the City of Agoura Hills, appointed by the Mayor and ratified by the City Council. The term of office for each commissioner shall be two (2) years.

The City Clerk published and posted an advertisement for Planning Commission applications on November 15, 2018. Any resident interested in being considered for appointment to the Planning Commission was provided the opportunity to submit an application.

In addition to the four (4) letters requesting re-appointment, received from Planning Commission incumbents Kate Anderson, John Asuncion, Michael Justice, and Curtis Zacuto, five (5) additional Planning Commission applications were received. A packet of all applications was distributed to each Councilmember for consideration.

Upon review of the applications, each Councilmember submitted the name of an appointee to serve on the Agoura Hills Planning Commission, for the two-year period of January 9, 2019, through January 13, 2021, as follows:
