THE BARBARA STANWYCK HOUSE

In 1937, Barbara Stanwyck formed a company with two partners, Zeppo Marx and Harry Hart. It was named the Devonshire Company. They purchased 120 acres of land, which was used to build a horse breeding business specializing in thoroughbreds. Miss Stanwyck used nine acres of this land for her own personal home, which was erected by architects Paul Williams and Robert Finkelhor. This home was a two-story English Tudor with five bedrooms, eight bathrooms, and four fireplaces, within 6,500 square feet. Of course, there was a pool and tennis court. Her home and grounds became known as Marwyck Ranch. On the remaining land that was the horse farm, quite a number of movies were filmed there, including "The Story of Sea Biscuit," and a Martin and Lewis comedy called "Money From Home." When Barbara Stanwyck married Robert Taylor, the house was sold to the movie star Jack Oakie, who renamed the ranch Oakridge. He lived there until his death in 1978. The house was then gifted to the City of Northridge, and is now open to tour. Lunch is at the Yard House, and is not included in the price of the trip. 


THE ARBORETUM





- A class receipt will be e-mailed to you if you provide an e-mail address, otherwise a receipt will be mailed to your home.
- 7. If your class section has already been filled, you will be placed on a waiting list with no money due.
- 8. Registrations will continue for classes until they are filled.
- 9. Class fees are due in full at the time of registration.

REFUND, TRANSFER AND CREDITS POLICY

GENERAL

- This policy applies to all departmentsponsored programs, activities and special instruction classes.
- 2. Request for refund, transfer or credit may be made by telephone or in person prior to the start of classes/camps/excursions.
- 3. All refunds, transfers or credits must be called in during business hours one business day prior to the start of class/camps/excursions. Business hours are Monday through Thursday from 7:00am-5:00pm, and on Friday from 7:00am-4:00pm. Requests for refunds, transfers or credits left on voicemail will not be honored. Refunds, transfers or credits requested prior to the start of the second class will be issued on a discounted basis. NO REFUNDS, TRANSFERS OR CREDITS AFTER THE SECOND CLASS.
- 4. Any cancellations made the day of camp (individual day camps only) will only be issued in the form of credit on account. Account credit will be kept on file for two years. There are no refunds for credit on account.
- 5. There are no refunds, transfers or credits for sports/specialty camps once camp has begun. Any refunds for sports/specialty camps must be called in one business day prior to the start of camp. Requests for refunds, transfers or credits left on voicemail will not be honored.

- No refunds, transfers or credits will be granted if cancellations for any program are made after the stated deadline, or if the program specifically states NO REFUNDS (unless cancelled by the department).
- 7. There are no refunds for Fitness Passes.
- 8. There is a \$5 processing fee for all refunds (unless cancelled by the department).
- 9. If registration was made on-line, the \$2 convenience fee will not be refunded unless the department cancelled the program.
- 10.All refunds under \$10 (after processing fee and any discounted fees are taken out) will be issued in the form of a credit on account. Credit on account is good for two years.
- 11. All lab/materials fees are non-refundable and are due to the instructor on the first day of class/camp.
- 12. There is a \$10 charge on all returned checks.
- 13. If the payment is made by credit card and the card is cancelled, lost or compromised, any request for a refund for an activity originally charged by that card will be issued a refund by check.
- 14. ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.

CANCELLATIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT

- 1. The Department of Community Services reserves the right to cancel any program in the event minimum registration is not met within 48 hours of the start date and are subject to review by staff.
- 2. A full refund will be issued in the event that a program is cancelled by the department prior to the start date.
- 3. A partial refund will be made in the event that a program is cancelled by the department prior to the conclusion of program.
- If registration was made online and the City has cancelled the program, the \$2 convenience fee will be refunded by the department. Payment for refund will be by check only.
- If the payment is made by credit card and the card is cancelled, lost or compromised, any request for a refund for an activity originally charged by that card will be issued a refund by check.
- 6. ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.

Water Conservation Efforts by the City of Agoura Hills

Why is the City watering parks and medians during a drought?

The City of Agoura Hills has historically and recently implemented a series of water conservation efforts in order to meet the recent recommendations of the Governor Brown, and the Las Virgines Municipal Water District. These conservation efforts relate to potable water (drinking water typically used in homes), while city parks and all but two of the City's medians are watered with reclaimed/recycled water. This water is captured from the local sewer pipes and cleaned to be used in public landscaped areas to avoid using valuable potable water. Nonetheless, the City is taking steps to conserve reclaimed and potable water whenever possible.

The City of Agoura Hills takes water conservation very seriously and has implemented conservation methods throughout its facilities and is always looking to utilize native and drought tolerant landscaping wherever possible.
