Mayor Northrup spoke about the issue of homelessness, recommended people contact the Lost Hills Sheriff's Station for assistance, announced she would be attending the Breakfast with the Bunny event, and reported that she and Councilmember Lopez had attended the Climate and Energy Festival hosted by GenUN and Agoura Hills and Calabasas High School students at The Event Center.
