THE BOOK CELLAR IS OPEN ON SATURDAYS FROM 10:00AM-4:00PM

The Book Cellar is a non-profit used bookstore run by volunteers of Friends of the Agoura Hills Library. It is located under the Agoura Hills Library. Revenues from The Book Cellar go towards funding programs and materials for the Agoura Hills Library, such as magazine subscriptions, periodicals, books, DVD and CD purchases, adult, teen and children's programs, and replacing and upgrading furniture. Not only that, but books are donated to schools in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, shelters, Department of Corrections and to other states and around the world. The Book Cellar is the used bookstore

that repeatedly comes up in the "Best Of..." editions of the "LA Weekly" (in three of the last five years.) In 2008, it garnered the "Best Literary Mine" and was named Best Used Book Store in L.A. and Ventura Counties. In 2010, it was "Best Excuse to Buy 'Crime and Punishment.'" It is only open on Saturdays from 10:00am-4:00pm, but donations can be left at the library at any time the library is open. The Book Cellar accepts monetary donations, books, CDs, DVDs, videogames, VHS videos, games, puzzles, furniture, comic books, maps, magazines, books on tape and household goods.

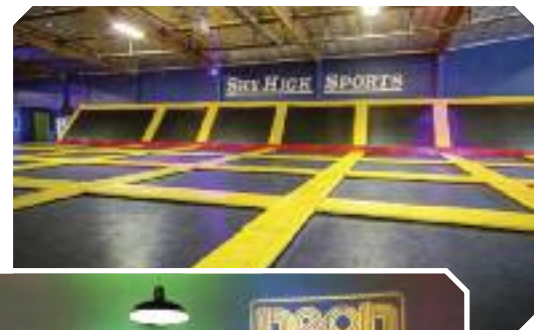

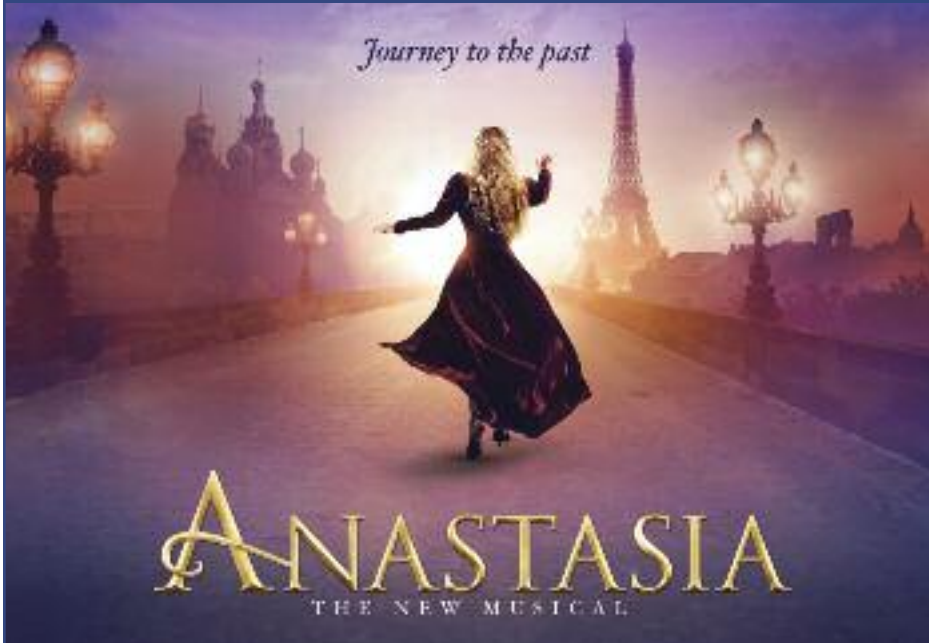

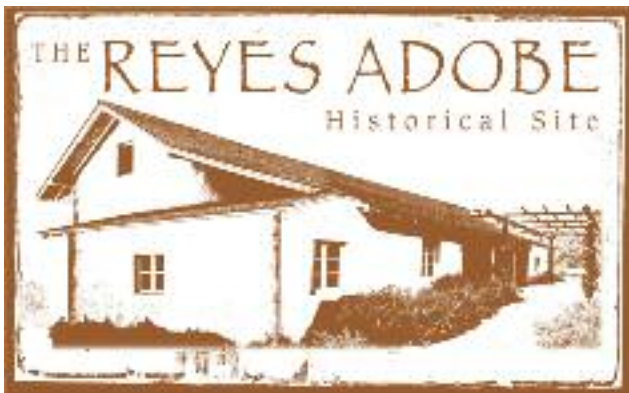

WHAT IS CERT?



Local government prepares for everyday emergencies. However, during a large disaster, the number and scope of incidents can overwhelm conventional

emergency services. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) traditionally known as the Disaster Response Team (DRT) in Agoura Hills; is designed to educate residents and businesses about emergency preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and instructs them in basic disaster response skills. Using the skills learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT-trained DRT members can give critical support to their families, neighbors, and community immediately following a disaster, when residents may initially be on their own and emergency services may not be available to help.

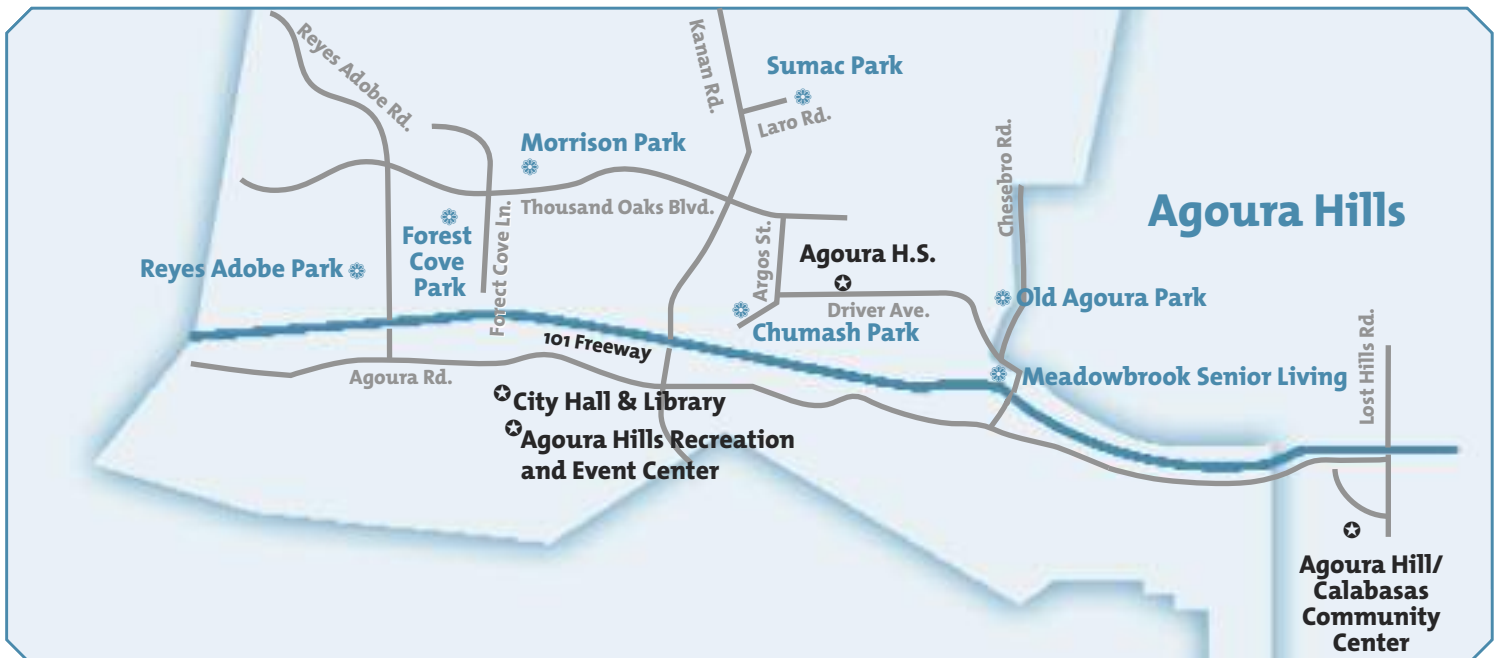

GENERAL RESERVATION POLICIES

Reservations for all facilities must be completed by an adult (18+ years) through the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center during regular business hours: Monday through Thursday from 7:00am-5:00pm, and Friday from 7:00am-4:00pm. Reservations for the Event Center are made only by appointment. The complete reservation policies are available from the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center, 29900 Ladyface Court in Agoura Hills, or call (818) 597-7361. Facilities cannot be reserved on

holidays, holiday weekends or when pre-scheduled City events are to occur. Anyone interested in making a reservation may do so by completing the appropriate reservation application, purchasing insurance through the City/providing proof of insurance coverage (non-profit groups only), and paying the facility reservation fees. Receipt of a reservation application by the City does not constitute approval of the reservation.

THE EVENT CENTER RESERVATIONS



The Event Center of Agoura Hills was designed to serve the community by offering a venue for private special events such as weddings, meetings, school reunions, fundraisers, and more. It includes a catering kitchen, outdoor patio, beautiful outdoor walkways, and a large lawn space with an amazing view. RECREATION CENTER RESERVATIONS



The Agoura Hills Recreation Center is a multi-use recreational facility, which was designed for public recreational programs/events. This facility is handicapped accessible, with two multi-purpose rooms (can be reserved as one large room), a classroom, and a conference room that are available to reserve. Available hours for reservations are Monday-Friday from 7:00am-11:00pm, and Saturday/Sunday from 8:00am-11:00pm. Reservation availability is determined based on existing recreational/departmental programs and any prior Event Center Reservations. Facility reservations may only be made up to three months in advance.

BASEBALL / SOFTBALL, FIELD / GRASS AREAS AND BASKETBALL COURT RESERVATIONS



Baseball/Softball fields, field/grass areas and basketball courts may be reserved by the general public or non-profit community groups for daytime play when City activities are not scheduled. Commercial use is not permitted for any Agoura Hills park. Available hours for reservations are Monday-Sunday from 9:00am-astronomical sunset. Reservation availability is determined based on existing recreational/departmental programs and any prior reservations. All facility reservations may only be made up to six months in advance.

REGISTRATION / REFUND INFO

REGISTRATION FOR ALL RECREATION PROGRAMS

1. Registrations will be accepted online, by mail, or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center. The Department of Community Services does not accept phone-in or fax-in registrations.
2. Registrations will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
3. Payments can be made online with a valid credit card.
4. Payments made by mail can be made with a check or valid credit card.
5. Payments made in person can be made by cash, check, or valid credit card.
6. If paying by check, make check payable to "City of Agoura Hills."
7. If mailing in registration using a credit card, please completely fill out the section at the bottom of the Registration Form.
8. A class receipt will be emailed to you if you provide an email address; otherwise, a receipt will be mailed to your home.
9. If your class section has already been filled, you will be placed on a waiting list, with no money due.
- 10.Registrations will continue for classes until they are filled.
- 11.Class fees are due in full at the time of registration.



Photographs are periodically taken of people participating in programs and activities. All persons registered in City activities or utilizing City Services thereby agree that any photograph may be used for the promotional purposes including, but not limited to, posting the photograph on the City's website, and/or its promotional, brochures, fliers, social media accounts, and other publications without additional, prior notice or permission and without compensation to the participant.

REFUND, TRANSFER AND CREDITS POLICY

GENERAL

1. This policy applies to all department-sponsored programs, activities, and special instruction classes.
2. Requests for refunds, transfers, or credits may be made by telephone or in person prior to the start of classes/camps/excursions.
3. All refunds, transfers, or credits must be called in during business hours, at least one business day prior to the start of class/camps/excursions. Business hours are Monday through Thursday from 7:00am-5:00pm, and on Friday from 7:00am-4:00pm. Requests for refunds, transfers, or credits left on voicemail will not be honored. Refunds, transfers, or credits requested prior to the start of the second class will be issued on a discounted basis. **NO REFUNDS, TRANSFERS, OR CREDITS AFTER THE SECOND CLASS.**
4. There are no refunds, transfers, or credits for sports/specialty camps once camp has begun. Any refunds for sports/specialty camps must be called in one business day prior to the start of camp. Requests for refunds, transfers, or credits left on voicemail will not be honored.
5. There are no refunds, transfers, or credits for Camp Agoura Hills once the camp day has begun. Any refunds for Camp Agoura Hills must be called in one business day prior to the start of camp. Requests for refunds, transfers, or credits left on voicemail will not be honored.
6. No refunds, transfers, or credits will be granted if cancellations for any program(s) are made after the stated deadline, or if the program specifically states **NO REFUNDS** (unless cancelled by the department).
7. There are no refunds for Fitness Passes.
8. There is a \$5 processing fee for all refunds for classes/camps/excursions/special events.
9. There is a minimum \$10 processing fee for all refunds on facility or park reservations (see Facility/Park Reservation Packets for full details).
- 10.All lab/materials fees are non-refundable and are due to the instructor on the first day of class/camp, and must be in the form of cash or check.
11. There is a \$10 charge on all returned checks.
12. All cash/check refunds under \$15 (after processing fee/administrative costs are taken out) will be applied to the account for credit. Credits on Account will be available to use for one year. Refunds under \$15 that were paid for by credit card will be refunded back to the credit card. Refunds over \$15 will be issued by check or refunded back to the credit card.

- 13.If the payment is made by credit card and the card is cancelled, lost, or compromised, any request for a refund for an activity originally charged by that card will be issued a refund by check.
- 14.**ALL REFUNDS FOR RAIN DATES FOR OUTDOOR PROGRAMS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE END OF EACH SESSION.**
- 15.**ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.**
- 16.**REFUNDS ARE ISSUED IN THE SAME MANNER PAYMENT WAS MADE.**

CANCELLATIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT

1. The Department of Community Services reserves the right to cancel any program, if minimum registration is not met within 48 hours of the start date. All cancellations are subject to review by staff.
2. A full refund will be issued in the event that a program is cancelled by the department prior to the start date.
3. A partial refund will be made in the event that a program is cancelled by the department prior to the conclusion of program.
4. All cash/check refunds under \$15 (after processing fee/administrative costs are taken out) will be applied to the account for credit. Credits on Account will be available to use for one year. Refunds under \$15 that were paid for by credit card will be refunded back to the credit card. Refunds over \$15 will be issued by check or refunded back to the credit card.
5. If the payment is made by credit card and the card is cancelled, lost, or compromised, any request for a refund for an activity originally charged by that card will be issued a refund by check.
6. If registration was made online and the City has cancelled the program, the \$2 convenience fee will be refunded by the department. Payment for refund will be by check only.
7. **ALL REFUNDS FOR RAIN DATES FOR OUTDOOR PROGRAMS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE END OF EACH SESSION.**
8. **ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.**

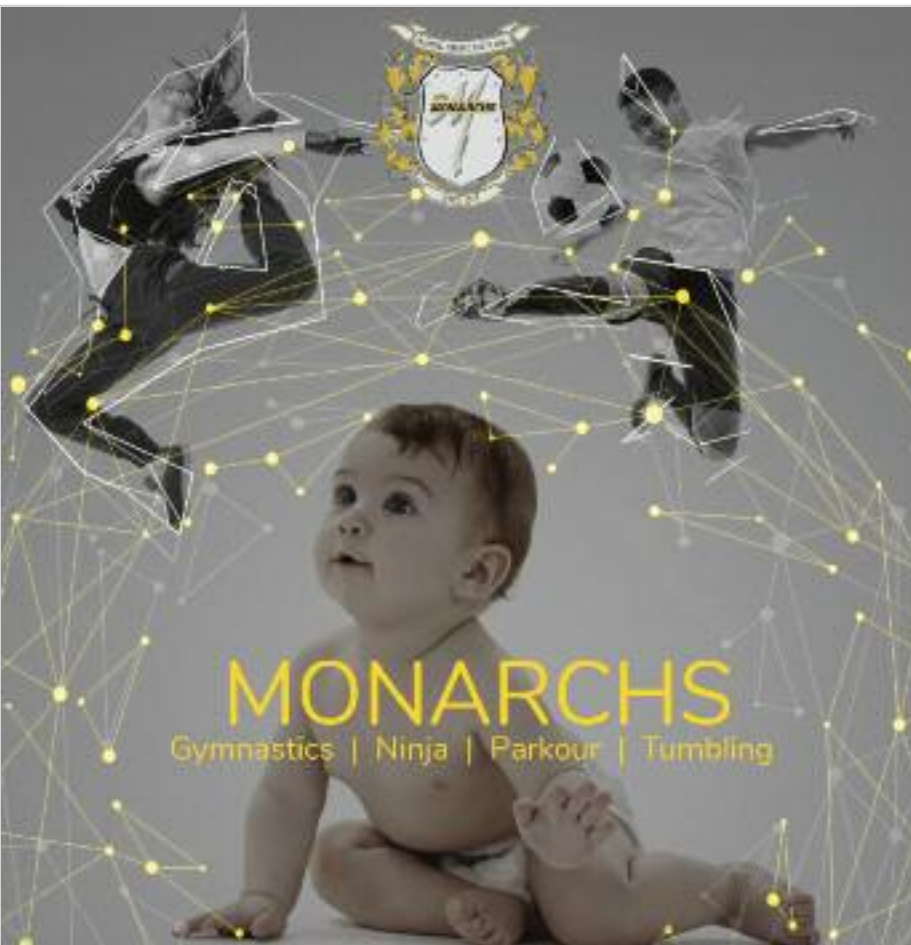


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
