**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS
AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM
IN THE THIRTY-FIRST PROGRAM YEAR (2005-2006)
AND SELECTING THE PROJECTS THAT ARE TO BE FUNDED**

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1974, President Nixon signed into law the Housing and Community Development Act (Act) of 1974; and,

WHEREAS, the primary goals of Title I of the Act are the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Agoura Hills has an opportunity to participate in the Urban County Community Development Block Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, the City has participated in the CDBG program since 1984 and many worthwhile projects have been completed with CDBG funds; and,

WHEREAS, suggestions have been requested from City departments for the utilization of these funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has published information regarding eligible activities under the Act and has conducted a duly noticed public hearing on January 12, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 30001 Ladyface Court, Agoura Hills, California; and,

WHEREAS, both oral and written testimony was presented to the City Council at the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Agoura Hills as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council authorizes the City to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program for the 31st program year (FY 2005-2006) and selects the following projects and allocation amounts:

<u>PROJECT</u>	<u>ALLOCATION</u>
Single Family Housing Rehabilitation Program	\$ 81,392 (78%)
Senior Citizen Recreation Program	\$ 15,774 (15%)
<u>CDBG Program Administration</u>	<u>\$ 8,000 (7%)</u>
TOTAL ALLOCATION	\$105,166 (100%)

Section 2. That the City Council approves the proposed CDBG program budget and instructs staff to submit the CDBG Program Planning Summary for approval to the CDC.

Section 3. That City staff is authorized to adjust the program budget as necessary to take into account the final CDBG allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and any amount remaining unspent at the close of the fiscal year.

Section 4. That the Mayor and/or City Manager are authorized to execute the contractual and related documents to be prepared by the County of Los Angeles that are required for the implementation of programs set forth herein.
