BACKGROUND

- May 29, 2020 – State approves County variance
- Revised Order allows reopening of restaurants
- Social Distancing priority
- 60% of normal indoor dining occupancy

URGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 20-450U

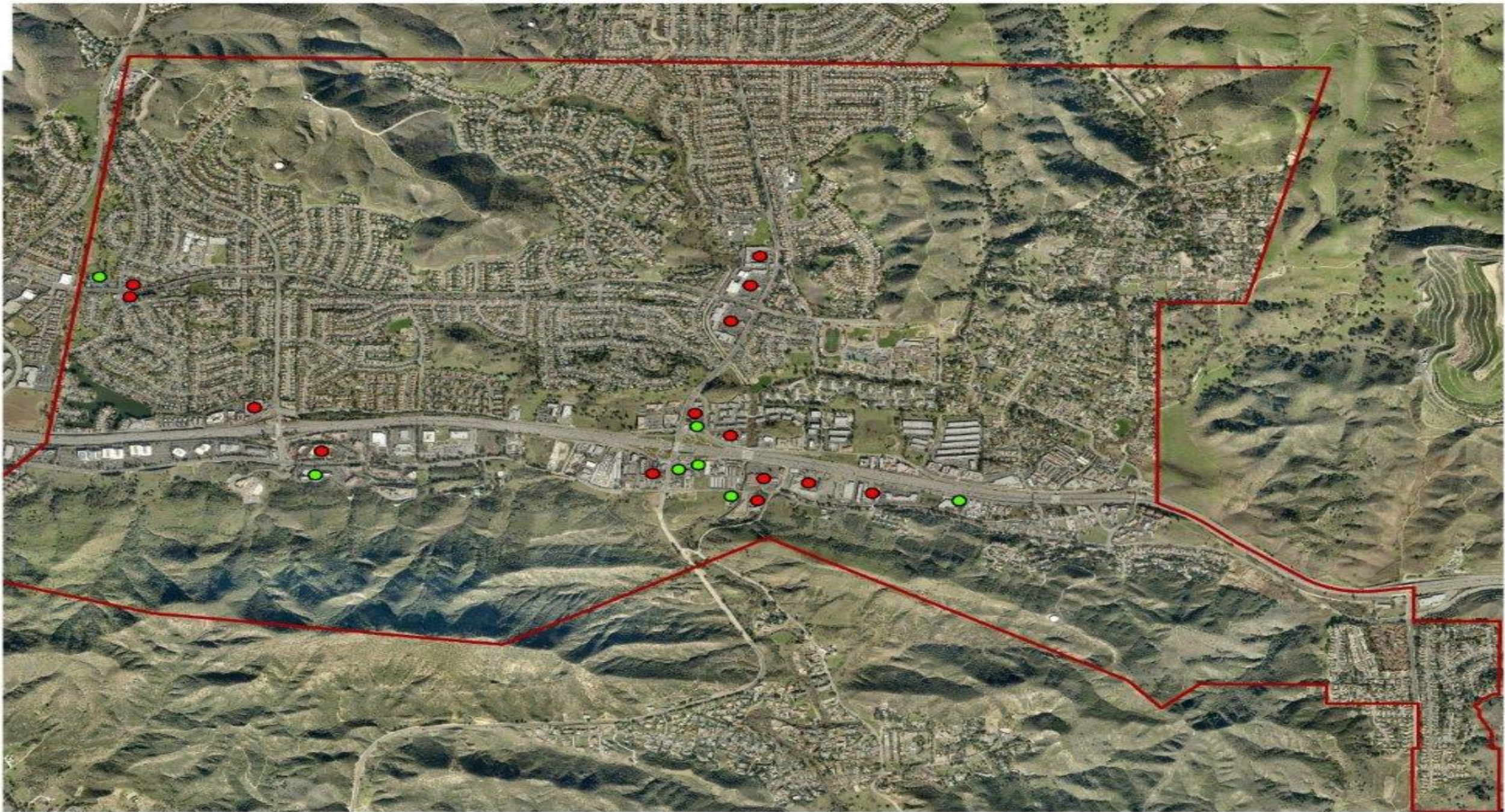
- Effective Immediately
- Enables immediate implementation of the Temporary Outdoor Dining Permit process
- Remains in effect until Council repeals

TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING PERMIT

- 24-hour turnaround (review and approval)
- Checklist to facilitate streamlined application process
- Expiration date of September 30, 2020
- No fee

COVID-19 RECOVERY AD-HOC SUBCOMMITTEE

- June 1, 2020
- Mayor Buckley Weber and Mayor Pro Tem Weber
- Discussion points:
 - Urgency Ordinance and Temporary Outdoor Dining Permits
 - Signage
 - PPE availability
 - Distribution of Information
 - Restaurant Visits by Council and Staff
