GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION - NOVEMBER 3, 2020

BY 4:00 P.M.*

MARCH 3, 2020 No candidate, including the candidate's controlled committee, shall accept any contributions

more than eight (8) calendar months prior to any election (Agoura Hills Municipal Code §21003 (h))

JUNE 10 (W) by E-120 City Council adopted Resolutions calling and giving notice of a General Municipal Election

for the election of certain officers, requesting the Board of Supervisors consolidate with the County of Los Angeles General Election, determining candidate statement regulations, and giving notice to the County to render specified services to the City of Agoura Hills.

(Elections Code §§ 10002, 10400, 10402, 10403, 12001, and 13307)

JULY 2 (Th) by E-113 "Notice of Election" for City Council candidates shall be posted and published by the City

Clerk in the Acorn and Ventura County Star newspapers.

(Elections Code § 12101, Government Code § 6061)

NOMINATION PERIOD JULY 13 (M) -E-113

AUGUST 7 (F) Nomination papers to be obtained and filed during this period for three (3) City Council seats. Each candidate shall be proposed by not less than 20 nor more than 30 registered BY 4:00 P.M. voters of the City of Agoura Hills. Candidate Statements must be filed during this period. *City Hall Closes at 4pm (Elections Code §§ 10220, 10224, 10407, 13307)

JULY 31 (F) FIRST SEMI-ANNUAL STATEMENT DEADLINE

BY 4:00 P.M. Last day to file Semi-Annual statement for candidates and committees for period *City Hall Closes at 4pm ending June 30, 2020. (Government Code § 84200)

AUGUST 7 (F) Last day to file resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk requesting consolidation with General Election.

(Elections Code §§ 10400, 10402, 10403)

AUGUST 7 (F) **END OF NOMINATION PERIOD – FILING DEADLINE**

Last day for candidates to file nomination papers including (optional) candidate statement (not to exceed 200 words). Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interests, and Local Forms *City Hall Closes at 4pm 10, 20, and 30, or 50 (if filing Form 470) are also due at the time of filing nomination papers. (Elections Code §§ 10220, 10224, 10407)

AUGUST 7 (F) Last day for candidate to withdraw nomination papers after being filed with the City Clerk,

BY 4:00 P.M.* except when nomination period is extended (Elections Code § 10224). *City Hall Closes at 4pm

AUGUST 10 (M)* E-87* Last day candidate statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, after being filed with BY 5:00 P.M. the City Clerk, during the period for filing nomination papers until 5 p.m. of the next working *Next Business Day is Monday day after the close of nomination period (Elections Code § 13307(a)(3)).

AUGUST 8* (Sa) - E-87* FILING NOMINATION PAPERS - EXTENSION AUGUST 12 (W) E-83 If nomination documents for an incumbent are not filed by 4:00 p.m. on August 7, 2020,

*City Hall Closed on Weekend the nomination period shall be extended until August 12, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., for persons other than the incumbent (Elections Code § 10225).

AUGUST 13 (Th) E-82 BY 5:00 P.M.

Last day candidate statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, after being filed with the City Clerk, if an incumbent does not file (Elections Code §13307(a)(3)).

BY 11:00 A.M.

Secretary of State shall hold a public drawing to determine the order of candidate names to appear on the ballot by randomly drawing each letter of the alphabet. (Elections Code § 13112)

AUGUST 14 (F)

E-81 Last day for City Clerk to file a certified list of qualified candidates with the County. (Elections Code § 10403)

AUGUST 20 (Th) E-75 Last day to cancel an election, due to insufficient number of candidates. (Elections Code § 10229)

SEPTEMBER 8* (Tu) – Filing period for write-in candidates to file with the City Clerk. OCTOBER 20 (Tu)E-57-14 (Elections Code §§ 8600, 8601, 10103)

*Date adjusted due to Holiday

SEPTEMBER 17 (Th)

City Clerk notifies candidates of first campaign filing requirement due on September 24, 2020.

SEPTEMBER 24 (Th)

FIRST PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DEADLINE

BY 5:00 p.m.

Last day to file campaign statement for candidates and committees for period ending September 19, 2020 (Government Code § 84200.7(b)(1)(2), 84200.8).

SEPTEMBER 24 (Th) – Official Sample Ballot Booklet mailed to each registered voter during this period. OCTOBER 13 (Tu)_{E-40-21} (Elections Code § 13303)

OCTOBER 13 (Tu) E-21 Last day County to mail Official Sample Ballot Booklet to each voter (Elections Code § 13303).

OCTOBER 15 (Th) City Clerk notifies candidates of third campaign filing requirement due on October 22, 2020.

OCTOBER 18 (Su) – E-8 Independent expenditures and campaign contributions in excess of \$5.00 received OCTOBER 26 (M) during this time must be reported to the City Clerk within 48 hours of receipt or expenditure via personal delivery, mailgram, telegram, or guaranteed overnight (Agoura Hills Municipal Code § 21007).

OCTOBER 19 (M) E-15 Last day to register to vote in November 3, 2020, General Municipal Election (Elections Code §§ 2102, 2107).

OCTOBER 20 (Tu) E-14 Last day to file as a write-in candidate. (Elections Code §§ 8600, 8601).

OCTOBER 22 (Th) E-12 Last day for City Clerk to file a certified list of qualified write-in candidates with the County.

OCTOBER 22 (Th) THIRD PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DEADLINE

BY 5:00 p.m.

Last day to file campaign statement for candidates and committees for the period covering October 4, 2020, through October 17, 2020 (Government Code § 84200.8).

OCTOBER 22 (Th) By E-7 Notice of Nominees for Public Office posted and published by the City Clerk in the Acorn and Ventura County Star newspapers (Elections Code § 12110, Government Code § 6061).

OCTOBER 22 (Tu) By E-7 Notice of Polling Places for the Consolidated Election posted and published by the City Clerk in the Acorn and Ventura County Star newspapers.

(Elections Code § 12105, Government Code § 6061)

BY OCTOBER 24* E-10 Notice of Central Tally Center for Counting Ballots posted and published by (Saturday) the County in a newspaper of general circulation (Elections Code § 12109).

OCTOBER 30 (Tu) E-7 Last day to file Vote by Mail application. (Elections Code § 3001)

Economic Interests filing requirement due January 7, 2021.

JANUARY 7, 2021 (Th) Last day for new Councilmembers to file Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interests

(Government Code § 87202 states that Councilmember must file within 30 days of assuming office).

JANUARY 21, 2021 (Th) Candidates notified of campaign filing requirement due on January 31, 2021.

FEBRUARY 1, 2021* (M) SECOND SEMI-ANNUAL STATEMENT DEADLINE

BY 5:00 p.m.

Last day to file campaign statement for candidates and committees for the period covering

*Next Business Day is Monday October 18, 2020, through December 31, 2020 (Government Code § 84200).

APRIL 1, 2021 (Th) Last day for all officeholders to file an Annual, Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interests

(Government Code § 87203).

JULY 22, 2021 (W) All candidates, officeholders and committees notified of campaign filing requirement due

on July 31, 2021.

AUGUST 2, 2021* (M) FIRST SEMI-ANNUAL STATEMENT DEADLINE

BY 5:00 p.m.

Last day to file campaign statement for candidates and committees for the period covering
