COUNCIL, STAFF COMMENTS

Councilmember Northrup spoke about the Breast Cancer Awareness proclamation and the importance of people getting their checkups and diagnostic screenings, and requested the meeting be adjourned *"in the honor of all of the women and men, who have courageously fought and successfully defeated breast cancer, and in the memory of those who equally courageously fought and lost that battle, but in their fight have contributed to research that are saving lives today."* Councilmember Anstead spoke about Halloween and encouraged everyone to wear their masks and practice social distancing, and reminded everyone to turn their clocks back on Saturday night.

Councilmember Lopez shared that nearly 50% of registered voters in Agoura Hills have voted, spoke about the vote centers in Agoura Hills, reminded residents that they can vote anywhere in Los Angeles County, and encouraged everyone to vote.

Mayor Pro Tem Weber spoke about breast cancer and shared his experience visiting Four Corners Park in Jackson Hole, Wyoming, and the elk antler arches were wrapped with pink lights in honor of breast cancer awareness month, wished everyone a safe Halloween, and encouraged everyone to participate in the City's upcoming virtual Halloween events.

Mayor Buckley Weber reported she had given her (virtual) State of the City address that is available for viewing on the City's website, the Artists 2020 Retrospective virtual Mayor's art show would be available on the City's website beginning November 5, shared that Agoura Hills had a Pulitzer Prize winner, Howard Rosenberg, and congratulated him on his new book *Blizzard of Lies*, and wished the Rams the best of luck.
