### Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) How to be Prepared

When there are potentially dangerous weather conditions in fire-prone areas, Southern California Edison may need to call a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event.

This event may temporarily shut off power to your neighborhood to prevent their electric system from becoming the source of an ignition. Turning off power to the community is not something that is taken lightly, but PSPS events are one of the ways to better ensure the safety of the public.

### Follow these tips in case of potential power shut offs during COVID-19.

- Install surge protectors to help safeguard electronic equipment
- Familiarize yourself with your home's utility boxes (electricity, water and gas) and how to turn them off; keep the proper tools handy
- Frequently back up important work and files on your computer
- Learn how to manually open your automatic garage doors or gates
- Keep the gas tank in at least one car half full

- You can safely use a portable gas generator in an outdoor location during a power outage - never use it indoors
- Make a safety preparedness plan for your family, including a list and location of the above items and a plan for how pets will be cared for
- Be prepared to meet the special needs of any infant, elderly, or disabled people in your household

- Build your own safety kit with the following:
- + FIRST AID KIT
- + PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS
- + BOTTLED WATER
- + FLASHLIGHTS & BATTERIES
- + NON-PERISHABLE FOOD
- + BATTERY-OPERATED RADIO

#### + ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Most common household hazardous waste and electronic waste, Sharps and non-controlled medicines.

- <u>NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:</u>
  Ammunition, Explosives, Asbestos,
  Liquid Mercury, Pressured
  Cylinders, Materials in Unlabeled
  or Leaking Containers.
- One bag per household. All items must fit inside kit bag, provided by At Your Door Special Collections and be sealed.
- + Electronic items are left outside the bag.

### Permitted Solid Waste Collectors – Temporary Bins

Are you aware that you have several choices for temporary solid waste bin service for those construction projects? The City has seven (7) permitted solid waste collectors from which you can select from. Each of these collectors is permitted to provide temporary bin service in the residential sector for your needs, and allows you to select the best price available. You should <u>only use</u> permitted collectors as they are required to divert a minimum of 50% of the waste collected from local landfills. Use of <u>unpermitted collectors is not</u> <u>allowed</u>. So the next time you need a temporary bin for that construction project, visit the City's website to obtain a list of the permitted collectors. You can also contact City Hall at (818) 597-7314 to check to see if the collector you are using is permitted.



# 2020 Christmas Tree Recycling Program

Agoura Hills will Participate in the County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County's Annual Christmas/Holiday Tree Recycling Program.

This "free" service provides Agoura Hills residents the opportunity to "recycle" their Christmas trees and extend the useful life of our local landfills. Flocked and fire retardant trees are also accepted! The trees are collected by Waste Management/G.I. Industries on your regular pick-up day.

Christmas trees collected this year will again be taken to the Calabasas landfill for recycling. The program will begin on **December 26, 2020** and **runs** until the second week in January.

## How to Participate?

Simply "cut up" your tree to fit inside your green waste container. Place your green waste container out on your regular collection day. Waste Management/G.I. Industries will collect it as part of the regular green waste collection.

Special collections are available, but customers must contact Waste Management/G.I. Industries for an appointment. There will be a charge for special collections. If you have any questions, please contact Solid Waste Solutions toll free at (805) 495-7521, or City Hall at (818) 597-7314.
