

PHASE 2 REOPENING OF LA COUNTY LIBRARIES

On April 19, 2021, LA County Library began the first phase of its gradual, tiered approach to reopening library locations to the public for select in-person services at 30 of 85 library locations. With Los Angeles County entering the orange tier of the State's [Blueprint for a Safer Economy](#), libraries were cleared to safely reopen at 50% capacity. We anticipate the County advancing into the yellow tier as soon as next week, if current numbers are maintained.

On May 10, 2021, the Library will begin its second phase of reopening by expanding to the 30 library locations listed below, bringing in-person services to a total of 60 LA County Library locations. Additionally, we will be increasing capacity limits at reopened libraries to 75%, while maintaining physical distancing of six feet between all customers and staff.

As stated in my previous memo announcing our first phase of re-openings, LA County Library's reopening plan prioritizes library openings based on geographic location, building availability, and the ability to accommodate physical distance guidelines and Public Health protocols. The Library placed an emphasis on equity and applied special consideration for reopening libraries in underserved areas where residents prioritize in-person services.
