

COVID-19 STATUS

After many months of low transmission, LA County is seeing a surge in cases similar to last summer, and is now at the level of high community transmission. While fully vaccinated people are well protected from severe infection, there is increased evidence that a small number of fully vaccinated individuals can become infected and may be able to infect others. COVID-19 can spread more easily indoors and in closed spaces, in crowded places, and in close contact settings. In LA County, a face covering is required in all indoor public spaces, regardless of vaccination status.

LA County-run vaccination sites will now be open on Sundays, expanding services to seven days a week. To view the updated schedule, visit VaccinateLACounty.com.

Chesebro Crossing Completed

Chesebro Crossing at the 101 was completed in late June. This project enhanced the bridge over Highway 101 and added safety improvements for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists. The overcrossing was expanded to create bike lanes and ADA-compliant (Americans with Disabilities Act) sidewalks. Local intersections were improved to enhance traffic circulation and safety.

The City is updating the Housing Element (HE) of the Agoura Hills General Plan. The State of California requires each city and county to adequately plan to meet the housing needs of everyone in the community, and requires the city or county to adopt a housing plan (known as a Housing Element) as part of its General Plan.

A General Plan is the City's "blueprint" for how it will grow and develop, and includes seven mandatory elements: Land Use, Transportation, Conservation, Noise, Open Space, Safety and Housing.

The City's Housing Element is updated and adopted every 8 years.

The changes that are made this year will be adopted through the year 2029.

As it is very important for the Housing Element to be reflective of the City, we hope you will participate in our outreach events and provide your comments to us on housing issues of concern to you.




