SUBJECT:	APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 05-1376 ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-06, RESOLUTION NO. 05-1377 ESTABLISHING FISCAL YEAR 2005-06 APPROPRIATIONS LIMITATIONS, AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY RESOLUTION NO.

Article XIII-b of the California State Constitution, known as Proposition 4, the Gann Initiative, was passed by the citizens of California on November 6, 1979. Proposition 4 placed limitations on the amount of annual appropriations for state and local governments. The legislation also provided a method to calculate the annual appropriation limit using a growth factor comprised of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for California per capital income and the percentage change in population.

**05-43 ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-06** 

The City of Agoura Hills appropriation limit for fiscal year 2005-06 is in the amount of \$11,546,405.

## RECOMMENDATION

The City Council held a budget workshop May 25, 2005 on budget matters. All concerns have been incorporated into a final budget. It would be appropriate to approve Resolution No. 05-1376 and the Agoura Hills Redevelopment Agency Resolution No. 05-43 adopting the Annual Budgets for Fiscal Year 2005-06 and Resolution No. 03-1377 Establishing the Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2005-06.
