The Agoura Hills Recreation Center is a multi-use recreational facility, which was designed for public recreational programs/events. Available hours for reservations are Monday-Friday from 7:00am to 11:00pm, and Saturday/Sunday from 8:00am to 11:00pm. Reservation availability is determined based on existing recreational/departmental programs and any prior Event Center Reservations. Facility reservations may only be made up to three months in advance.

Picnic Shelters, baseball/softball fields, grass areas, and basketball courts may be reserved by the general public or non-profit community groups for daytime play when City activities are not scheduled. 
