


Learn About Your Voting Options



The LA County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is the official source for accurate and unbiased election information and voting resources. Voting has never been easier, more convenient, and more secure. Read how you can prepare for the election!



How can I register to vote? When is the registration deadline?

If you've moved, are new to LA County, or voting for the very first time, you **must** register to vote by May 23, 2022 to receive a Vote by Mail ballot. The easiest way to register to vote is to visit **LAVOTE.GOV**.

If you don't have access to the internet, paper voter registration cards are available at most government buildings – like libraries or DMV offices.

Can I track my Vote by Mail Ballot?

Yes! You can track your ballot every step of the way by subscribing to *Where's My Ballot?* (california.ballottrax.net) for free. You will receive notifications by text message, email, or voicemail on the status of your mailed ballot. After you return your ballot you will also receive a notification of when it is received at the Registrar's office and that it will be counted.

What are my voting options?

- 1. **Vote by mail.** Every registered voter in LA County will be mailed a ballot for the June Primary Election. Ballots will start mailing on May 5th. All you have to do is fill it out, sign the Return Envelope, and send it back. Don't wait. Vote early!
- 2. **Drop off at a Ballot Drop Box.** You can avoid lines at a Vote Center by voting early and returning your ballot at one of 400 Official Ballot Drop Box locations. A list of convenient locations near you is included in the Vote by Mail packet.
- 3. Visit any Vote Center beginning May 28th. If you vote in person, save time with the mobile Poll Pass! It's a convenient way to save time at a Vote Center by making your selections before you leave the house. A separate mailing will be sent to every registered voter showing the nearest Vote Center locations.
