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DEMOLITION PERMIT GUIDELINES

OP-05

- 1. The demolition of a structure requires a Building Permit.
- 2. A separate permit shall be obtained for each building or structure. The permit shall show the type of demolition procedure to be used.

Exception:

Single Family Dwellings and accessory buildings can be combined

- 3. Demolition permits may be issued with a notarized letter from the owner or a copy of the signed contract indicating that the contractor has been hired to perform the demolition to
 - a. a demolition contractor (Class C-21)
 - b. a general engineering contractor (Class A)
 - c. a licensed general contractor (Class B-1) if the structure to be demolished is a one-story and the contractor will perform both demo and new construction onsite. (Indicate on the demolition permit that the "Contractor will perform both demo and new construction onsite")
- 4. Plan requirements:
 - a. Provide current survey with existing structures. The Site plan/Plot plan is acceptable if no apparent property line and is signed by a licensed architect or engineer.
 - b. Property dimensions, dimension and size of all structures to be demolished, adjacent streets and alleys, fences, walls
 - c. Clearly identify other site structures to remain or to be removed.
 - d. Provide standard BMP to include site construction fencing, dust control, tree protection,
- 5. The demo plan requires approval
 - a. Planning
 - b. Building Approvals: (Usually over the counter for non-historic structures)
- 6. Additional Approval/Permits
 - a. Building Safety A separate permit is necessary for the capping off each utility and sewer connection
 - i) Plumbing Permit (BS): capping off existing plumbing lines
 - ii) Electrical Permit (BS)
 - b. Engineering Approval by the Public Works Department shall be obtained prior to the issuance of a permit
 - i) In all cases where a protection fence or canopy must be constructed in the public way or where barricading a street, an "Encroachment Permit" shall be obtained from Public Works Department
 - ii) For any demolition work which removes the lateral support from a public way when the wall that provides lateral support for a public way, and/or any of the building elements that stabilize the wall are being demolished.
 - c. A notification to the Air Quality Management District (AQMD) of the intent to demolish. All AQMD Rule 1403 submittals shall be completed online at:

 - d. OSHA clearance is required for structures over 36'-0" or 3 stories in height.
 - e. Dig Alert Notification Notice
 - f. Only Permitted waste haulers are allowed to provide waste disposal and recycling services for construction and demolition projects within city limits.
