Volunteer on Patrol

The City of Agoura Hills and the Lost Hills Sheriff's Station are actively seeking new members for the Volunteers on Patrol ("VOP") Program. VOP's actively patrol their communities and act as "eyes and ears" to advise deputies of suspicious activities, accidents, and other safety hazards. VOP's also help maintain public safety by providing services such as traffic control, and otherwise assisting deputies and/or civilians as necessary. The VOP's receive specialized training from the Sheriff's Department in such areas as:

- Traffic Control
- Patrolling the community for criminal activity and safety hazards
- Disaster Response
- First Aid and CPR
- Vacation and Business Checks
- Assisting with special events (parades, races, holiday fairs)

VOP's come from all walks of life and socio-economic levels. The team includes working professionals, retirees and college students. All members are required to be at least 18 years of age, pass an oral interview and background check, have a clean driving record, attend a Sheriff's Driving Course, and patrol at least 16-hours per month.
