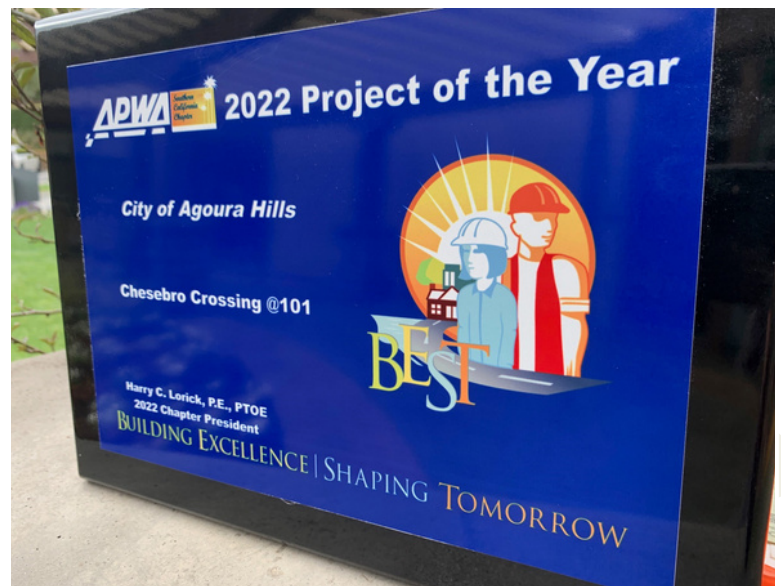

## Homeowners Exemption

The Los Angeles County Assessor Jeffrey Prang joined the Agoura Hills City Council meeting and shared that 1 in 3 people are overpaying on their property taxes. A "Homeowner's Exemption" can lower your taxes by \$70 if you own your home and live in it as your primary residence. If you qualify the reduction will be applied to next year's tax bill.

All new residential and commercial developments have building requirements for:

ELECTRIC VEHICLE SERVICE EQUIPMENT



The new Energy Reach Code began on February 26th, 2023. Newly constructed buildings must be designed and built as All-Electric Buildings. Newly constructed buildings must include specific types and certain amounts of EV parking spaces.

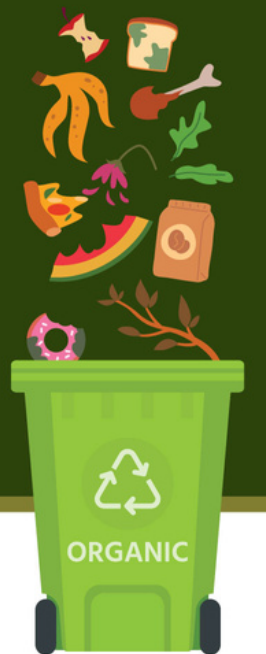

## Bi-Monthly Hazardous Waste Program



The City of Agoura Hills also has a limited Bi-Monthly Hazardous Waste Program (every other month), that is available where you can deposit waste oil as well as other hazardous items.

Open to residents of Agoura Hills, Westlake Village, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, and Malibu.

**Acceptable Items:** used oil; oil filters; anti-freeze; car batteries; latex paint (water based only).

**Unacceptable Items:** stains; varnish; enamel paints (oil based), pesticides, household batteries.

**When:** First Saturday of the Month (Jan, Mar, May, July, Sept, Nov.).
