  - LOCATION: 28439 Foothill Drive (AIN 2055-019-037)
  - ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines.
  - ZONING DESIGNATION: Residential Very Low Density – Old Agoura Design Overlay – Equestrian Overlay (RV-OA-EQ)
  - GENERAL PLAN DESIGNATION: RV (Residential Very Low)
  - **RECOMMENDATION**: Staff recommended the Planning Commission approve Conditional Use Permit Case No. CUP-2021-0005 and Site Plan/Architectural Review Case No. SPR-2021-0008;

subject to conditions, based on the findings of the Draft Resolution.

During the presentation, Staff noted the following correction to Condition No. 24:

"The property owners agree to preserve the areas of the lot above the 1,050-foot topographic elevation line as permanent open space <u>per the</u> <u>recorded conservation easement</u>. The property owners shall record a land conservation easement against the property, satisfactory in form to the Planning Director. Evidence of such recordation shall be provided to the satisfaction of the Planning Director prior to issuance of a grading permit or building permit, whichever occurs first."
