## **INTERGOVERNMENTAL, SPECIAL PURPOSE COMMITTEE, & DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

Greater Conejo Valley Chamber of Commerce President/CEO, Danielle Borja, provided a Chamber Update.

Councilmember Sylvester provided a Las Virgenes/Malibu Council of Governments Update.

~~Mayor Pro Tem Buckley Weber reported that, as Vice Chair on the Environmental Policy Committee for CalCities, she attended the first in-person meeting in June and, upon receiving guidance from City staff regarding her ability to vote pursuant to the City's legislative platform, she voted against AB 460 and AB 1337, as both of these bills would take away local control and give control to the State Water Resources Board, however, the Committee approved supporting AB 460 and took a neutral position on AB 1337.~~

Mayor Pro Tem Buckley Weber reported that, she attended the first in-person meeting of the Environmental Policy Committee for CalCities in June and the Committee was asked by CalCities to take a position on AB 460 and AB 1337. As the Vice Chair of the Committee, and, as both of these bills would take away local control and give control to the State Water Resources Board, she reached out to, and received guidance from, City staff regarding her ability to vote pursuant to the City's legislative platform. Although the Environmental Policy Committee for CalCities approved supporting AB 460, she voted against it. With regards to AB 1337, Mayor Pro Tem Buckley Weber joined the Committee in taking a neutral position on AB 1337.

Councilmember Wolf reported that AB 460 was pulled by the author yesterday and would not be getting a hearing and AB 1337 would be getting a hearing on July 10, 2023.
