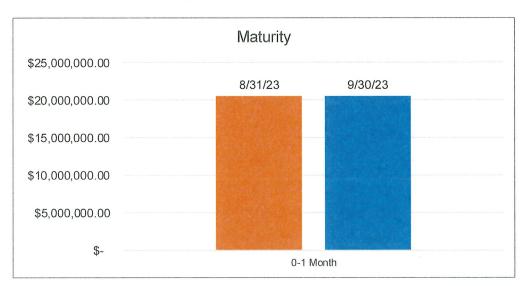

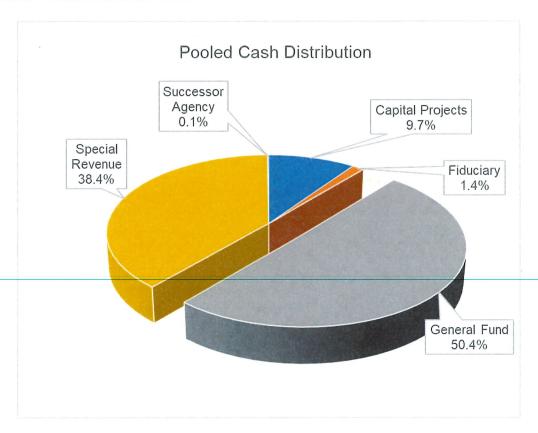


PORTFOLIO MATURITY
