Highway (101) (Ventura Freeway) in Agoura Hills will be closed at night with a detour on Agoura Road

WHAT'S HAPPENING

On U.S. Highway 101, all lanes will be closed **in one direction** each night for five hours starting at 11:59 p.m. Monday through Friday for construction of the Wallis Annenberg Wildlife Crossing. The schedule is subject to change due to weather or operational reasons.

WHERE

Highway 101 will be closed in Agoura Hills between Liberty Canyon Road and Chesebro Road. The starting date for these closures will be announced soon. Closures will occur on Monday through Friday nights for several weeks. Each night, only one direction will be completely closed – lanes in the opposite direction will stay open for traffic.


WHEN

WHY

These closures are for the safety of the public while crews place girders over the freeway to construct the Wallis Annenberg Wildlife Crossing, a vegetated bridge across Highway 101 to reconnect wildlife habitat. It will be the largest wildlife crossing of its kind.

LOCAL STREET DETOUR

Some freeway lanes may begin closing as early as 7 p.m. Complete closure (all lanes) will start at 11:59 p.m. All lanes will be open by 5 a.m. (except Saturdays). Times and dates are subject to change.

LOCAL DETOUR:

A detour on local streets will be provided via Agoura Road, Liberty Canyon Road, and Chesebro/Palo Comado Canyon Road. Signs will show the route for motorists.

OTHER ROUTE OPTIONS:

Please see the all-freeway detour on Page 2 (highly recommended). Also, motorists may consider using other routes such as State Route 126 to avoid the closure area. Before starting your travel, please check current highway closures at QuickMap.dot.ca.gov

ALL-FREEWAY DETOUR

Highly recommended for trucks and all vehicles to avoid delay



FREEWAY DETOUR:

When northbound 101 is closed, motorists going from Los Angeles to Ventura County can bypass the closure by going north on I-405, west on the 118 freeway, and south on the 23 freeway to northbound 101 in Thousand Oaks. Reverse this route when southbound 101 is closed.
