SUBJECT: CONTINUATION OF A DE NOVO PUBLIC HEARING TO JULY 10, 2024,

TO CONSIDER AN APPEAL OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION'S DENIAL OF CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NUMBER CUP-2023-0026, A REQUEST FOR A TYPE-47 ALCOHOL LICENSE TO ALLOW THE SALE OF DISTILLED SPIRITS, WINE, AND BEER, AND TO REVISE THE

EXISTING RESTAURANT'S HOURS OF OPERATION

The applicant/appellant, Stephen A. Jamieson, on behalf of David Foldes, owner of Cronies Sports Grill, is requesting the City Council continue the public hearing for the appeal of the Planning Commission's denial of Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. CUP-2023-0026 to the July 10, 2024, City Council meeting.

On April 18, 2024, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 24-1290 denying CUP-2023-0026, a request for a Type-47 alcoholic beverages license and to revise the hours of operation of the existing Cronies Sports Grill.

Following the public notice of the May 22, 2024, appeal hearing, the applicant requested the City Council continue the public hearing to July 10, 2024, because the applicant is unable to be present at the hearing on May 22, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT

This appeal application will have no impact on the City's Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget as the applicant has paid all applicable fees, which covers staff's time processing the case and public notification fees.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the applicant's request, staff recommends the de novo public hearing for the appeal of the Planning Commission's denial of Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-2023-0026 be continued to the July 10, 2024, City Council meeting.


