Wallis Annenberg Wildlife Crossing on Highway 101 May 31-June 7, 2024

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Crews are working on and around the girders which span the freeway.

Crews are installing rebar (reinforcing rods) to construct the bridge deck above the girders, and other work.

- Day work is scheduled Monday through Friday.
- Night work may be done on some nights, Monday through Friday.
- The schedule is subject to change due to weather or operational reasons.

CLOSURES AND DETOURS

Highway 101 is open to traffic in both directions at night, every night, until further notice. Caltrans has <u>finished</u> the recent series of nightly "full-freeway" (complete) closures. In the future, full-freeway closures may be scheduled on dates to be announced.

When lanes or ramps must be closed at night, the following schedule applies:

- The Southbound 101 Liberty Canyon Off-Ramp and the Northbound 101 Liberty Canyon On-Ramp may be closed after 7 p.m. and will be open by 6 a.m. every morning except in unusual circumstances or on weekends.
- Starting at 7 p.m., one lane on Northbound 101 may be closed. Starting at 8 p.m., one lane on Southbound 101 may be closed.
- Starting at 10 p.m., two lanes may be closed in either direction. A third lane may be closed southbound after 11 p.m., and northbound after 12 a.m. (midnight). At least one lane in each direction will be open for traffic.
- By 5 a.m., all freeway lanes (excluding exit/entrance lane) will be open.

Daytime ramp closures may occur intermittently Mondays through Fridays:

• The Southbound 101 Liberty Canyon Off-Ramp and the Northbound 101 Liberty Canyon On-Ramp may be closed intermittently between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The schedule is subject to change due to weather or operational reasons.
