



Wildfire Preparedness

The City of Agoura Hills wants to ensure our residents are adequately informed and prepared for a future event.

Please review the information and checklist below.

Wildfire Evacuation Orders

- Evacuation Warnings may be issued for a particular area in the event of a wildfire.
- Consider leaving if a voluntary evacuation order is given.
- Be prepared to evacuate those in need of special assistance and possibly pets and equine.
- An Evacuation Order is a directive from the Sheriff and/or Fire Department to leave your home or business immediately for your own safety.
- Failure to follow an evacuation order may result in endangerment to the lives of others, personal injury, or death.

Wildfire Preparedness Checklist

- Contact family members & make sure they are ready to leave.
- Put personal belongings and documents in your vehicle.
- Cover windows, attic openings, eaves, and vents with fire resistive material.
- Close all windows and doors around your home to keep sparks from blowing inside.
- Move furniture away from windows and sliding glass doors to avoid them igniting from the fire's radiant heat.
- If you have children in school, follow the school's Disaster Plan.
- Follow the evacuation plan instructions and the directions from Public Safety.
- Drive carefully at a normal speed with your headlights on.
